ABOUT THE VINNIE DELMER MEMORIAL TECHNICAL/TRADE SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship was established by Vinnie Delmer's family and funded by donations from many of the people whose lives were touched by Vinnie Delmer. Vinnie graduated from Elizabeth Forward High School and taught elementary education for 37 years in the Elizabeth Forward School District. She was a life member of the Elizabeth Forward Alumni & Friends Association and active in its scholarship program.

TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

One scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded to a graduating senior at Elizabeth Forward High School intent on furthering his or her education as a full-time student at a technical/trade school for medical technician, electrician, mechanic, etc.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants will be judged on the above criteria and the applicant's written response to the prompt at the end of this application. Applicants should have a sustained record of academic excellence and excellent attendance in high school and be a well rounded student involved in extra-curricular activities, leadership, volunteerism, and/or community service.

SELECTION PROCESS

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review all complete applications based on the above criteria and the applicant's written response to the prompt on the last page of this application.

NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to EFABA to receive the scholarship. One half of the scholarship funds will be presented at the EFHS Senior Awards Evening in early June. The remaining funds will be awarded for the recipient's second semester of study.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Complete the application on next page.
- Prepare an up-to-date personal resume.
- Place **three copies of the application and resume** in an unsealed envelope. Write your name in the upper left corner of the envelope and the scholarship name in the middle of the envelope.
- Submit all materials to your guidance counselor by March 31.
- Request that your counselor provide EFABA with your EFHS academic transcript. You need only one transcript even if you are applying for more than one scholarship administered by EFABA.
- If you have additional questions or need more information, contact your guidance counselor.
