ABOUT THE EFSD AND T.D. CLUB GOLF OUTING SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships were established by the Elizabeth Forward School District and T.D. Club with funds donated from the Annual Elizabeth Forward School District and T.D. Club Golf Outing.

TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

Two \$750 scholarships (one for males and one for females) will be awarded to graduating seniors at Elizabeth Forward High School who have excelled in academics while attending EFHS. Applicants should be intent on furthering their study as a full-time student at a two- or four-year college or trade or technical school. Students may apply for more than one Golf Outing Scholarship, but only one EFSD and T.D. Golf Outing Scholarship will be awarded to an individual.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection will be based on merit as judged by the selection committee. Applicants must have a minimum QPA of 3.00, be a student in good standing and demonstrate pride in their school, have participated in extra-curricular activities, and submit one letter of reference.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review all complete applications based on the above criteria and the applicant's written response to the prompt on the last page of this application.

NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to EFAPA to receive the scholarship.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Complete the application on next page.
- Prepare an up-to-date personal resume that includes your academic achievements, senior-year courses, extra-curricular activities, and community service.
- Place **three copies of the application and resume** in an unsealed envelope. Write your name and the scholarship name on the outside of the envelope.
- Submit all materials to your guidance counselor by March 31.
- Request that your counselor provide EFAPA with your EFHS academic transcript. You need only one transcript even if you are applying for more than one scholarship administered by EFAPA.
- If you have additional questions or need more information, contact your guidance counselor.
