### **ABOUT THE MARILYN HOUSE WEST BOOK SCHOLARSHIP**

The scholarship was established by Marilyn House West, a member of the Class of 1962 and the Elizabeth Forward High School Hall of Fame. Ms. West is the owner and operator of M. H. West & Co., Inc., a Virginia-based management consulting company.

### **TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP**

One or more scholarships of at least \$250 but not more than \$500 will be awarded graduating female seniors at Elizabeth Forward High School intent on furthering their education as full-time students at a four-year college or university. Monies shall be used towards the purchase of books at the college or university. Ms. West will determine the amount of the scholarship each year.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

The scholarship is for females who are interested in pursuing careers in healthcare or business. Candidates should rank in the upper 10% of the graduating class and be an active participant in extra-curricular activities. Financial need will not be a determining factor for selection. Afro-American females will be given preference.

### **SELECTION PROCEDURE**

Marilyn House West will review all complete applications based on the above criteria and the applicant's written response to the prompt on the last page of this application.

### **NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP**

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to EFAFA to receive the scholarship.

### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

- Complete the application on next page.
- Prepare an up-to-date personal resume that includes your academic achievements, senior-year courses, extracurricular activities, and community service.
- Place **three copies of the application and resume** in an unsealed envelope. Write your name and the scholarship name on the outside of the envelope.
- Submit all materials to your guidance counselor by March 31.
- Request that your counselor provide EFAFA with your EFHS academic transcript. You need only one transcript even if you are applying for more than one scholarship administered by EFAFA.
- If you have additional questions or need more information, contact your guidance counselor.
