ABOUT THE STAFF SERGEANT BRYAN HOOVER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship was established by friends and family of Staff Sergeant Bryan Hoover and funded by donations from many of the people whose lives were touched by Bryan Hoover. He served two tours in the Middle East as a Marine before joining the PA Army National Guard's Company C 1st Battalion, 110th Infantry. He was a 2000 graduate of EFHS where he returned as an assistant track and cross country coach. He received a bachelor's degree in sports management from California University of Pennsylvania, where he also volunteered with many youth sports programs. Bryan died Friday, June 11, 2010, in the line of duty in Afghanistan.

TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is restricted to graduating seniors who were members of the EFHS Cross Country and/or Track and Field Team. Applicants should intend to further their education as a full-time student at a four-year college or university.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants will be judged on the above criteria and the applicant's written response to the prompt at the end of this application. Applicants should have a sustained record of academic excellence and excellent attendance in high school and be a well rounded student involved in extra-curricular activities, leadership, volunteerism, and/or community service.

SELECTION PROCESS

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review all complete applications based on the above criteria and the applicant's written response to the prompt on the last page of this application.

NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to EFAFA to receive the scholarship.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Complete the application on next page.
- Prepare an up-to-date personal resume that includes your academic achievements, senior-year courses, extracurricular activities, and community service.
- Place ***three copies of the application and resume*** in an unsealed envelope. Write your name and the scholarship name on the outside of the envelope.
- Submit all materials to your guidance counselor by March 31.
- Request that your counselor provide EFAFA with your EFHS academic transcript. You need only one transcript even if you are applying for more than one scholarship administered by EFAFA.
- If you have additional questions or need more information, contact your guidance counselor.
