ABOUT THE R. T. LONG PENN STATE UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship was established by Mika (EF '71) and Bob (EF '71) Long in honor of their son, Robert Tyler Long (EF '06 and PSU '10), to acknowledge his academic and personal achievements and to give back to the school district to recognize its key role in providing Robert's solid academic foundation.

TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior at Elizabeth Forward High School intent on furthering his or her education as a full-time student at Penn State Erie or Penn State University Park Campus. Applicants planning to complete an engineering major will be given preference.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection will be based on merit as judged by the selection committee. Applicants should have a sustained record of academic excellence, leadership, and citizenship.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review all complete applications based on the above criteria and the applicant's written response to the prompt on the last page of this application.

NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to EFAFA to receive the scholarship.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Complete the application on next page.
- Prepare an up-to-date personal resume that includes your academic achievements, senior-year courses, extracurricular activities, and community service.
- Place **three copies of the application and resume** in an unsealed envelope. Write your name and the scholarship name on the outside of the envelope.
- Submit all materials to your guidance counselor by March 31.
- Request that your counselor provide EFAFA with your EFHS academic transcript. You need only one transcript even if you are applying for more than one scholarship administered by EFAFA.
