ABOUT THE TIMOTHY PETTY SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship was established by the Elizabeth Elementary School PTA to recognize and honor Timothy Petty who retired in June 2006 after completing 30 years of service to the Elizabeth Forward School District. Although throughout his tenure with EFSD, Mr. Petty served in many capacities; his final years were well spent nurturing the children of Elizabeth Elementary as their Principal. His dedication to education demonstrated that his was a vocation, a calling if you will, rather than an occupation.

TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

One scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to a graduating senior at Elizabeth Forward High School who attended Elizabeth Elementary School and intends to further his/her education at a college or university.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection will be based on merit as judged by the selection committee. Applicants should have a sustained record of academic excellence and performed community service.

SELECTION PROCESS

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review all complete applications based on the above criteria and the applicant's written response to the prompt on the last page of this application.

NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to EFAPA to receive the scholarship.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Complete the application on next page.
- Prepare an up-to-date personal resume that includes your academic achievements, senior-year courses, extracurricular activities, and community service.
- Place **three copies of the application and resume** in an unsealed envelope. Write your name and the scholarship name on the outside of the envelope.
- Submit all materials to your guidance counselor by March 31.
- Request that your counselor provide EFAPA with your EFHS academic transcript. You need only one transcript even if you are applying for more than one scholarship administered by EFAPA.
- If you have additional questions or need more information, contact your guidance counselor.
