**ABOUT THE PENN'S WOODS SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship was established by Becketts Run Woodlands a family owned and operated sustainable forestry business in Forward Township.

**TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP**

One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior at Elizabeth Forward High School intent on pursuing a natural resources related career. Applicants must demonstrate a respect for the natural environment. Additionally, those active in Boy Scouts, Girls Scouts, 4-H, or an equivalent youth group will be given the highest consideration.

**SELECTION CRITERIA**

Selection will be based on merit as judged by the selection committee. In addition to the above criteria, applicants should have a record of participation in extra-curricular activities, leadership, volunteerism, and/or community service, a record of sustained academic achievement, and demonstrate financial need.

**SELECTION PROCEDURE**

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review all complete applications based on the above criteria and the applicant's written response to the prompt on the last page of this application.

**NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP**

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to EFAFA to receive the scholarship.

**APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

- Complete the application on next page.
- Prepare an up-to-date personal resume that includes your senior-year courses and information that support the selection criteria.
- Place **three copies of the application and resume** in an unsealed envelope. Write your name and the scholarship name on the outside of the envelope.
- Submit all materials to your guidance counselor by March 31.
- Request that your counselor provide EFAFA with your EFHS academic transcript. You need only one transcript even if you are applying for more than one scholarship administered by EFAFA.
- If you have additional questions or need more information, contact your guidance counselor.
