ABOUT THE RENDIN LAW ENFORCEMENT SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship was established by Phil and Betty Rosnick Rendin, both EFHS alumni, Class of 1968. Phil, retired F.B.I., is also a member of the EFAFA Hall of Fame (2004).

TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior at Elizabeth Forward High School intent on furthering his or her education as a full-time student at an accredited college or university.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection will be based on merit as judged by the selection committee. Applicants should have a documented financial need and a sustained record of academic excellence and participation in extra-curricular activities. Applicants pursuing study in law enforcement, criminal justice, or one or more of the natural sciences will be given preference in the order listed.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review all complete applications based on the above criteria.

NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to EFAFA to receive the scholarship.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Complete the application on next page.
- Prepare an up-to-date personal resume that includes your academic achievements, senior-year courses, extracurricular activities, and community service.
- Place **three copies the application and resume and one copy of the financial need documentation** in an unsealed envelope. **Please blacken out all social security numbers in the financial need documentation.** Write your name and the scholarship name on the envelope.
- Submit all materials to your guidance counselor by March 31.
- Request that your counselor provide EFAFA with your EFHS academic transcript. You need only one transcript even if you are applying for more than one scholarship administered by EFAFA.
- If you have additional questions or need more information, contact your guidance counselor.
