ABOUT THE JON AND SANDY SHANK ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship was established at Robert Morris University by two Elizabeth Forward High School alumni. Jon Shank was graduated in 1960 and Sandy Dick Shank in 1963. Jon, Professor Emeritus at Robert Morris University, is a member of the Elizabeth Forward High School Hall of Fame. Jon and Sandy are proud of their high school and have been supportive of the Elizabeth Forward Alumni and Friends Association and the Elizabeth Forward Student Aid Association.

TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior at Elizabeth Forward High School who has been accepted and will study as a full-time student at Robert Morris University or to an EFHS alumnus who is studying as a full-time student at Robert Morris University.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection will be based on merit as judged by the selection committee. Applicants should have a sustained record of academic achievement, demonstrated leadership skills through extra-curricular and/or community service involvement. Students majoring in education may receive preference.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review all complete applications based on the above criteria.

NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to EFAPA to receive the scholarship. Robert Morris University will be notified by EFAPA to award the funds to the recipient.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Complete the application on next page.
- Prepare an up-to-date personal resume that includes your academic achievements, senior-year courses, extracurricular activities, and community service.
- Place **three copies of the application and resume** in an unsealed envelope. Write your name and the scholarship name on the outside of the envelope.
- Submit all materials to your guidance counselor by March 31.
- Request that your counselor provide EFAPA with your EFHS academic transcript. You need only one transcript even if you are applying for more than one scholarship administered by EFAPA.
- If you have additional questions or need more information, contact your guidance counselor.
