ABOUT THE T.D. CLUB FOOTBALL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship was established by the T.D. Club, an organization that exists to assist in providing a positive experience for all those who participate in the Elizabeth Forward football program.

TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

This \$1,000 scholarship is restricted to graduating seniors who were members of the EFHS Football team during their senior year. Applicants should intend to further their education as a full-time student at a post-secondary school, including technical schools, community colleges, or four-year colleges or universities.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants will be judged on the above criteria and the applicant's written response to the prompt at the end of this application. Applicants should have a sustained record of academic excellence in high school and be a well rounded student involved in extra-curricular activities, leadership, volunteerism, and/or community service.

SELECTION PROCESS

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review all complete applications based on the above criteria and the applicant's written response to the prompt on the last page of this application.

NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to EFAPA to receive the scholarship.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Complete the application on next page.
- Prepare an up-to-date personal resume that includes your academic achievements, senior-year courses, extracurricular activities, and community service.
- Place ***three copies of the application and resume*** in an unsealed envelope. Write your name and the scholarship name on the outside of the envelope.
- Submit all materials to your guidance counselor by March 31.
- Request that your counselor provide EFAPA with your EFHS academic transcript. You need only one transcript even if you are applying for more than one scholarship administered by EFAPA.
