ABOUT THE BONNIE BASHFORTH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship was established by Laurie Bashforth Walton in honor of her mother, Bonnie Bashforth. Bonnie, EFHS Class of 1959, at age 25 courageously completed her high school education as a widow and mother. Laurie Walton is a member of the EFHS Class of 1971 and the EFHS Hall of Fame.

TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

One scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to a graduating senior at Elizabeth Forward High School intent on furthering his/her education as a full-time student at a four-year college or university.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The selection will be based on merit as judged by the selection committee. Applicants should provide evidence that he/she challenges him/herself amidst obstacles while sustaining academic excellence and personal accountability, and applicants should demonstrate a financial need.

SELECTION PROCESS

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review all complete applications based on the above criteria and the applicant's written response to the prompt on the last page of this application.

NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to EFAPA to receive the scholarship.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Complete the application on next page.
- Prepare an up-to-date personal resume that includes your academic achievements, senior-year courses, extracurricular activities, community service, etc.
- Place **three copies of the application and resume, and one copy documentation of financial need** in an unsealed envelope. Write your name and the scholarship name on the outside of the envelope.
- Submit all materials to your guidance counselor by March 31.
- Request that your counselor provide EFAPA with your EFHS academic transcript. You need to provide only one transcript even if you are applying for more than one scholarship administered by EFAPA.
- If you have additional questions or need more information, contact your guidance counselor.
