### **ABOUT THE FOUR FRIENDS FOR ELEMENTARY EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP**

The scholarship was established by Vinnie Delmer, Carla Gealy, Mary Havel, and Lynn Vogt. All are Elizabeth Forward graduates and served as elementary teachers in the Elizabeth Forward School District. They all recognize the importance of early education in a child's life and the dedication of their teachers.

### **TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP**

One scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded to a graduating senior at Elizabeth Forward High School intent on furthering his or her education as a full-time student at a four-year college or university majoring in Elementary Education (Grades Pre K through 8).

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

Applicants will be judged on the above criteria and the applicant's written response to the prompt at the end of this application. Applicants should have a sustained record of academic excellence and be a well rounded student involved in school activities and community service.

### **SELECTION PROCESS**

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review all complete applications based on the above criteria and the applicant's written response to the prompt on the last page of this application.

### **NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP**

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to EFAPA to receive the scholarship.

### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

- Complete the application on next page.
- Prepare an up-to-date personal resume that includes your academic achievements, senior-year courses, extracurricular activities, and community service.
- Place **three copies of the application and resume** in an unsealed envelope. Write your name in the upper-left corner of the envelope and the scholarship name in the middle of the envelope.
- Submit all materials to your guidance counselor by March 31.
- Request that your counselor provide EFAPA with your EFHS academic transcript. You need only one transcript even if you are applying for more than one scholarship administered by EFAPA.
- If you have additional questions or need more information, contact your guidance counselor.
