# 2012 ANN V. MALADY SCHOLARSHIP

### **ABOUT THE ANN V. MALADY SCHOLARSHIP**

The scholarship was established by John and Kristin Malady in honor of John's sister, Ann Malady. Ann, EFHS Class of 1970, taught in the elementary grades in the EF school district for 28 years, including 20 years in the gifted program for elementary students. John Malady is a member of the EFHS Class of 1972 and the EFHS Hall of Fame. Kristin Malady grew up in Minnesota and moved to Pennsylvania after graduating from the University of Minnesota.

### **TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP**

One scholarship of \$1,250 will be awarded to a graduating senior at Elizabeth Forward High School who has dealt successfully with a learning disability and is intent on furthering his or her education as a full-time student at a two- or four-year college or university or vocational institution.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

Applicants should have an IEP or equivalent assessment and a record of participation in extra-curricular activities, leadership, volunteerism, and/or community service.

### **SELECTION PROCESS**

Mr. and Mrs. John Malady, or a committee selected by them, will review all complete applications based on the above criteria and the applicant's written response to the prompt on the last page of this application and determine the recipient.

### **NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP**

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to EFAPA to receive the scholarship.

### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

- Complete the application on next page, including having your guidance counselor verify that you have an IEP or equivalent assessment.
- Prepare an up-to-date personal resume that includes your academic achievements, senior-year courses, extracurricular activities, and community service.
- Place **three copies of the application and resume** in an unsealed envelope. Write your name and the scholarship name on the outside of the envelope.
- Submit all materials to your guidance counselor by March 31.
- Request that your counselor provide EFAPA with your EFHS academic transcript. You need only one transcript even if you are applying for more than one scholarship administered by EFAPA.
- If you have additional questions or need more information, contact your guidance counselor.
