

# 2019 EFSAF BONDI AND FLEISCHAUER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION STUDENTS

Four \$2,000 scholarships for college sophomores, juniors, and seniors will be awarded in August 2019.

- Three scholarships are funded by the Elizabeth Forward Student Aid Fund (EFSAF) to honor the memory of **Dr. Frank Bondi**, a prominent surgeon, who established the EFSAF in 1962 and served as its president until 1992. During these 55+ years, EFSAF has supported the higher education goals of EFSD residents because of Dr. Bondi and those who joined with him or carried on after him.
- One scholarship is funded by Jane Fleischauer to honor her deceased husband, **Michael Fleischauer**, EFHS Class of 1964. Mike was a teacher in the North Allegheny School District and served on the EFSAF Board of Directors because it was important to him to be able to give back to his community as well as EFSAF that supported him while he was in college.

## APPLICATION INFORMATION

The application is to be submitted as a *Word* document to Carolyn Adams at [alc6740@gmail.com](mailto:alc6740@gmail.com) and should provide the information in the **Application section** below. **Applications must be received by July 1, 2019. Notifications of awards will take place in August.**

You are eligible to apply if you:

- Are a graduate of Elizabeth Forward High School.
- Are continuing your education as a full-time student at an accredited trade/technical school or two- or four-year college or university (referred to as college in this application).
- Have a home address within the Elizabeth Forward School District.
- Submit a completed application and copies of your college transcript and fall course schedule.

Reviewers will use the following criteria when evaluating your application. Your

- Most recent college cumulative grade point average (CGPA) and other scholastic accomplishments and/or awards.
- Participation in **collegiate extracurricular** activities and the attainment of leadership roles.
- Community service activities while enrolled in college.
- Employment activities while enrolled in college.
- Written essay. The essay will be assessed on its originality, how well it is written, and English usage skills.

14. Write a 300-500 word essay (double-spaced) on the following topic: **Mentors in the workplace aid in the integration and training of new employees. Are they equally important in college? Discuss the importance of, your personal opinions about, and your experiences with a mentor/mentee relationship (Have you been a mentor to someone? Have you been mentored?). Tell us how this relates to your time in college and your future.**

2. Obtain a copy of your college transcript that records courses and credits taken as well as your current cumulative grade point average. The transcript does not have to have an institutional seal.
3. Obtain a copy of your upcoming fall semester course schedule.
