ABOUT THE LAWRENCE HOWELL, SR. AND ELAINE MILLER HOWELL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship was established by their children—Betty Jane Howell Berich (EFHS Class of 1964), Donna Howell Carney (EFHS Class of 1970) and the late Lawrence Howell, Jr. (EFHS Class of 1974). Lawrence and Elaine are graduates of EHS, Class of 1941 and Class of 1944 respectively. Mr. Howell was inducted into the EFAFA Hall of Fame in 2000.

TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

One scholarship of \$1,500 will be awarded to a graduating senior at Elizabeth Forward High School intent on furthering his or her education at an accredited trade school or community college

SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review all complete applications based on the applicant's sustained record of academic excellence and attendance.

NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to EFAFA to receive the scholarship. Information relating to a required thank you letter will be included with the confirmation letter.

2. Prepare an up-to-date personal resume that includes your academic achievements, senior-year courses, extracurricular activities, community service, etc.
3. Make three copies of all application materials (including your resume) and collate them into three separate packets so each packet contains one copy of each document and then staple each packet.
4. Place all three packets into one unsealed 9 x 12 envelope.
5. Write your name and the scholarship name on the outside of the envelope.
6. Submit all materials to your guidance counselor as soon as possible but not later than February 28.
7. Request that your counselor provide EFAPA with your EFHS academic transcript.
