## ABOUT THE RUBY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is funded by the Anglican Church of Elizabeth in memory of Ruby Cunningham. We recognize Ruby as she was a Christian woman who was active in her community and church outreach programs. We wish to recognize and encourage those same qualities in subsequent generations.

## TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

One scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded to a graduating senior at Elizabeth Forward High School intent on furthering his or her education as a full-time student at a trade school, two-year college, or four-year college or university.

## SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA

The recipient will be selected by an EFAFA Selection Committee based on the applicant's GPA of 2.75 or higher, church attendance, active relationship with a church, involvement in community service outside the church, and written response to the prompt on the next page. A reference letter from your pastor, leader of your church group, or a non-relative character reference will be needed.

## NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail or text message and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to EFAFA to receive the scholarship. Information relating to a required thank you letter will be included with the confirmation letter.

Write a 400-500-word essay (double-spaced) on this prompt: **How do you view Christ as working in your life and also the community service in which you are involved?**
2. As a separate document, prepare an up-to-date personal resume that includes your academic achievements, senior-year courses, extracurricular activities, and church and community service, etc.
3. Make two copies of all application materials (including your essay, resume, and letter of reference) and collate them into two separate packets so each packet contains one copy of each document and then staple each packet.
4. Place both packets into one unsealed 9 x 12 envelope.
5. Write your name and the scholarship name on the outside of the envelope.
6. Submit all materials to your guidance counselor as soon as possible but not later than February 28.
7. Request that your counselor provide EFAPA with your EFHS academic transcript
