## ABOUT THE RUBY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is funded by the Anglican Church of Elizabeth in memory of Ruby Cunningham. We recognize Ruby as she was a Christian woman who was active in her community and church outreach programs. We wish to recognize and encourage those same qualities in subsequent generations.

## TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

Two scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded to a graduating senior at Elizabeth Forward High School intent on furthering his or her education as a full-time student at a trade school, two-year college, or four-year college or university.

## SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA

The recipient will be selected by an EFAFA Selection Committee based on the applicant's GPA of 2.75 or higher, church attendance, active relationship with a church, involvement in community service outside the church, and written response to the prompt on the next page. A reference letter from your pastor, leader of your church group, or a non-relative character reference will be needed.

## NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail or text message and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to EFAFA to receive the scholarship. Information relating to a required thank you letter will be included with the confirmation letter.

2. As a separate document, prepare an up-to-date personal resume that includes your academic achievements, senior-year courses, extracurricular activities, and church and community service, etc.
3. Email the application, the essay, the letter of reference, and the resume as **separate PDF attachments** to [EFafa.Board@gmail.com](mailto:EFafa.Board@gmail.com) as soon as possible but not later than February 28. The filename must indicate the specific scholarship and the component of the application, for example: rubymemorial\_application.pdf and rubymemorial\_essay.pdf. Place the name of the scholarship in the Subject heading.
